Program Description	SS4A grants support planning, infrastructure, and behavioral and operational initiatives to prevent fatalities and serious injuries on roads and streets involving all roadway users, including pedestrians, bicyclists, public transportation, motorists, and commercial vehicle operators. The program provides funding to develop tools to strengthen a community’s approach to roadway safety and is designed to meet the needs of local, Tribal, and regional communities. Authorized under IIJA, Pub. L. 117-58, with \$5,000,000,000 in advanced appropriations.
